Therefore, the student after completion of three years will be awarded degree in Major and Minor subject.
5. Student cannot select a subject as major or minor other than the subjects taken in first year
6. Frame each course having even number of credits such as 2 or 4 credit.
7. This UG credit structure is applicable for all the programmer across all faculties, except the programmes that require approval from apex bodies like AICTE, PCI, BCI, COA, NCTE, etc.

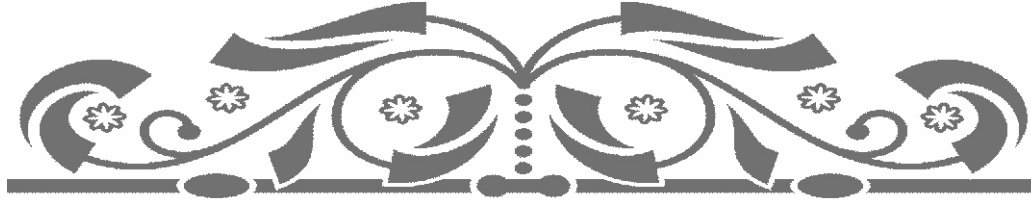
